A RESOLUTION OF THE ORANGELINE DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF
TRANSIT ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FUNDING APPLICATION
TO THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION

THE ORANGELINE DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY DOES HEREBY FIND,
RESOLVES AND ORDERS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Executive Director of the Orangeline Development Authority ("Authority") is authorized to apply for Transit Oriented Development (TOD) Program funding from the Los Angeles County Transportation Authority ("Metro").

Section 2. The Authority's Executive Director is authorized to accept the TOD funding if awarded by Metro to the Authority.

Section 3. The Authority's Executive Director is authorized to execute all documents, including contracts, subcontracts, agreements extensions, renewals, and/or amendments required by Metro to implement the TOD project.

Section 4. The Secretary shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.
